The MSU Law School Courtroom is located at 648 N. Shaw Lane, East Lansing, MI 48824. The Courtroom is located on the fourth floor of the Law School Building in Room 428. There is a parking structure adjacent to the MSU Law School Building, which provides public parking and MSU employee parking. Public parking is by pay per plate. You must park in a space designated as a "Pay by Plate" parking space. Signage has been installed in these areas. Parking in a space not designated as "Pay by Plate" parking may result in a parking violation. Immediately after


parking, enter license plate number and payment into the lot's spoton pay station or via the MSU SPOTON app. Pay stations accept cash payment or credit cards. They do not give change back nor are refunds issued for time paid for but not used.

The MSU Board of Trustees' Room is located at the John A Hannah Administration Building, 426 Auditorium Road, Michigan State University, East Lansing, MI 48824. The Board of Trustees' room is on the fourth floor, Room 401. Visitor parking may be found in various locations near the Hannah Administration building. 2. Exhibit and Witness Lists Apparently there is some confusion as to the timing for the filing of original or amended exhibits and witness lists. Five sets of all exhibits, whether original or amended, shall be filed with Kara Yermak, with a copy to the opposing party, by 5:00 PM on Friday, August 2, 2019. Five sets of witness lists shall also be filed with Kara Yermak, with a copy to the opposing party, by 5:00 PM on Friday, August 2, 2019. Ms. Yermak will make the distribution to the members of the Hearing Committee and to its legal advisor. If exhibits are not timely filed, the Hearing Committee will consider motions to strike the testimony of witnesses to which the exhibits relate and reserves the right to strike such testimony on its own motion.

Both parties will also have a screen and projector available to them to either: 1) display any exhibits, and 2) utilize video conferencing (Zoom) for purposes of witness attendance. Please inform Kara Yermak of your intent to use technology for either or both of these purposes by 5:00 PM on Friday, August 2, 2019. If either party chooses to utilize technology for these purposes, the parties are responsible for: 1) providing a thumb drive which contains the electronic exhibits on the days of the hearings, and 2) providing the names and contact information for the witnesses who will be participating via Zoom video conferencing. Kara Yermak will provide instructions regarding the Zoom video conferencing to the witnesses on bFriday, August 9, 2019.
